

How to Pray

Using the Lord's Prayer pattern

This prayer guide is not intended to be a verbatim speech! On the contrary, it is an incredibly powerful outline to help keep you on track during your prayer time.

The guide uses the Lord's Prayer as its basis. There are six topics in the Lord's Prayer:

The first topic is praise. You can use scripture to praise the Lord, or you can make up your own praise. Also, thank God for the Blood that Jesus spilled for us so we can be made free from sin. When using scripture, personalize it. Some examples are as follows.

The fifth topic is spiritual warfare.

Thank you that I can be strong in the Lord and in the power of his might.

b. Thank you that I am putting on the whole armor of God that I might stand for God always.

c. I put on the belt of truth. I will speak the truth. Your Word is truth. I will speak the Word of God!

d. I put on the breastplate of Righteousness. Jesus is my righteousness. Because Jesus is in my heart, and I am truly living for Him, I am clean and pure before God no matter what anyone else says !

e. I put on the shoes of peace. I will be peaceful. I will speak words of peace, not fighting. I will walk in God's perfect will because the steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord.

I take the shield of faith. Faith comes by hearing the Word of God. I will speak the Word of God, and I will resist the devil and he will flee from me.

g. I put on the helmet of salvation. Jesus , you are my salvation. I put Jesus Words in my mind. I will think, speak, and live the Words of Jesus.

h. I take up the Sword of the Spirit which is the Word of God. I will speak out God's promises for me from the Bible.

The sixth topic is praise.

Begin by Thanking the Lord for the Blood of Jesus

This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins. -MAT 26:28

“This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many,” he said to them. -MAR 14:24

In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you. -LUK 22:20

Instead, one of the soldiers pierced Jesus’ side with a spear, bringing a sudden flow of blood and water. -JOH 19:34

Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church of God, which he bought with his own blood. -ACT 20:28

Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God’s wrath through him! -ROM 5:9

Is not the cup of thanksgiving for which we give thanks a participation in the blood of Christ? And is not the bread that we break a participation in the body of Christ? -1CO 10:16

In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me.” -1CO 11:25

In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God’s grace -EPH 1:7
But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near through the blood of Christ. -EPH 2:13

and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross. -COL 1:20

How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God! -HEB 9:14

In fact, the law requires that nearly everything be cleansed with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness. -HEB 9:22

Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, -HEB 10:19

by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, his body, -HEB 10:20

and since we have a great priest over the house of God, -HEB 10:21

let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. -HEB 10:22

And so Jesus also suffered outside the city gate to make the people holy through his own blood. -HEB 13:12

May the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, -HEB 13:20

equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. -HEB 13:21

who have been chosen according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through the sanctifying work of the Spirit, for obedience to Jesus Christ and sprinkling by his blood: Grace and peace be yours in abundance. -1PE 1:2

For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your forefathers, -1PE 1:18

but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect. -1PE 1:19
